RULES FOR THE KNOLL

All existing cemetery rules and regulations, when applicable, also apply to The Knoll and the cremation burials on its grounds. The dignity of this memorial must be maintained at the highest standards possible. Therefore, the following set of rules has been established for reasons of neatness, uniformity, maintenance and also to prevent damage to the area itself. These rules must be agreed to, in advance of purchase, and will be strictly enforced by cemetery personnel.

These rules are subject to change at any time without notice.

1. Inurnment in, or inscription on, any niche may be scheduled only after all charges have been paid in full.
2. Cemetery personnel will make all inurnments, interments and removals.
3. Any niche inurnment will require the use of a container subject to Oak Lawn's approval. Burials in the cremation lots will include the use of a cremation vault provided by Oak Lawn. The price of the cremation vault is included in the opening fee for the grave.
4. On the day of inurnment or interment, a single floral arrangement will be permitted in the area adjacent to the inurnment or interment. It will be removed after one additional day.
5. All inscriptions on any niche will be of a standard form, size, color, and style of lettering prescribed by the cemetery, and will be done only by authorized cemetery personnel. Inscription charges shall be paid in full before the inscriptions are engraved. Inscriptions will be limited to first name, middle name/initial, last name, year of birth and year of death, provided there is room on the niche front. A small religious insignia, of a size established by the cemetery, will be permitted.
6. Nothing, including but not limited to flowers and pictures, shall be taped or otherwise affixed to the niche fronts.
7. All plantings in The Knoll area will be done and maintained by cemetery personnel. No artificial flowers or artificial plantings, including those made of silk, are permitted at The Knoll.

8. No plantings are permitted in front of the stone cremation walls. Fresh cut flowers in a cone shaped vase are permitted.
9. All inground memorials included as part of the cremation lot itself, shall be of a style and color designated by Oak Lawn. **Government (Veteran) markers will not be permitted in The Knoll.**
10. No items shall be placed on the granite tops of the niche bank walls, columbariums or stone walls along the pathways. Each day cemetery personnel will remove any such item(s).
